State Police net three in Aggravated burglary case

Thursday, August 7, 2008, at approximately 4:30 pm, New Mexico State Police officers responded to a burglary call in the Mineral Hill area. The officers met with Mr. Michael Anderson who stated that his home had been burglarized. Mr. Anderson explained that someone had kicked in the back door of the residence. Mr. Anderson said a Gateway computer, a .22 caliber handgun and alcohol had been stolen from the residence. When the officers completed the investigation, Mr. Anderson asked if they would check on another vacant residence in the area before they left. The officers traveled to the residence and upon arrival noticed that there was smoke coming from the chimney and movement in the residence.

The officers intercepted a subject at the back door and noticed that the screen door had been pried off and thrown on the ground. The Gateway computer, .22 caliber handgun and alcohol were all located in the residence. The officers took three (3) subjects into custody.

Mark Overby, DOB: 01-0-87, 224 Cabraсто Road, Questa, New Mexico 87556, was charged with Aggravated Burglary (2nd Degree Felony), Breaking and Entering (4th Degree Felony), Larceny (4th Degree Felony), Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor (2 Counts – 4th Degree Felony), Possession of Marijuana (Petty Misdemeanor), and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (Misdemeanor). Overby was incarcerated in the San Miguel County Detention Center with a \$60,000.00 cash only bond.

The additional subjects were juvenile subjects. A sixteen year old male from the San Geronimo area and a fifteen year old female from Las Vegas were transported to and incarcerated in the Santa Fe Juvenile Detention Center. They will face similar charges in the Children's Court Division of District Court.
